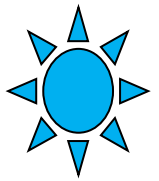


PHRASAL VERBS

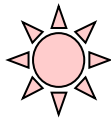


Phrasal verbs are a combination of words that is used like a verb and consists of a verb and an adverb or a preposition.

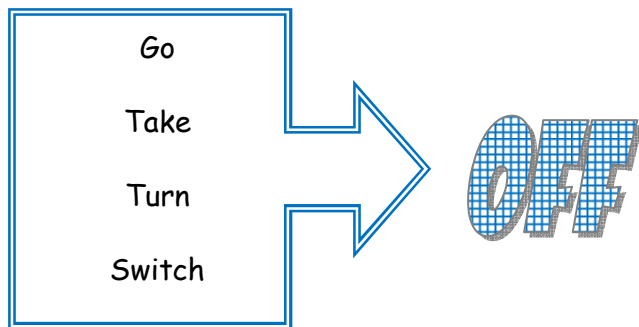

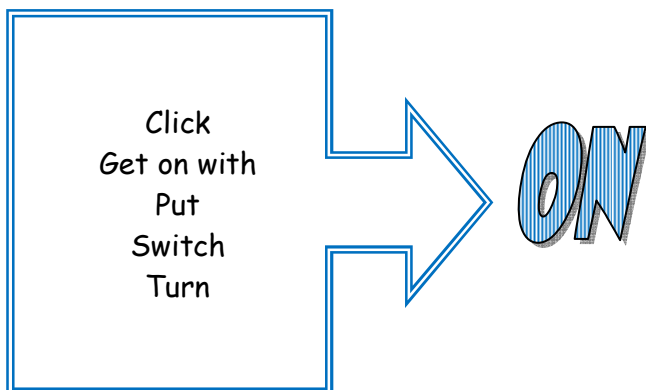
